- Introduce bibliometrics, open citation and other methods to analyse and show the "impact" of alternative publishing






On the road to Open Access Journals • (**BOAI 2**)

- The Councils for Research in the Humanities and Social Sciences in Denmark, Finland, Norway, and Sweden have formed a joint board (NOP-HS) for the purpose of allocating grants to Nordic scientific periodicals in the humanities and social sciences. Approximately 40 periodicals receive yearly grants.
